

serif: The finishing stroke at the end of a stem or other letter-stroke ascender: Stroke of any lowercase letter which extends above the x-height descender: Stroke of any lowercase letter wich extends below the x-height The height of lower case letters without ascenders or descenders x-height: The vertical stroke of a letter stem: bracket: The rounded junction of a serif with a stroke (variation in its shape affects the character of the letter) bowl: The curved part of certain letters The space enclosed or partly enclosed by a letter counter: The boldness or thickness of a letter weight: The angle of the thickest part of a bowl stress:
